From the WCTC Foundation Chairperson

In 1995, the WCTC Foundation Board made a resolution to advance its efforts in supporting the needs of WCTC students and programs through a new strategic plan and expanded leadership. This Biennial Report marks ten years since this initiative was embraced and the results have been greater than ever imagined.

Since 1995, the Foundation has received more than \$10.3 million in contributions. These contributions reflect \$5.4 million in monetary gifts and over \$4.9 million of in-kind gifts. During this time period, 7,973 gifts were received from generous donors. WCTC students received \$1,822,574 in scholarship support from these gifts to benefit their educational advancement. The Foundation is currently steward to 65 scholarship funds, 81 advised funds, and 42 endowments, for a total of 188 donor directed funds. These funds have experienced a 91% growth rate over the past ten years.

Remarkable progress, with a great future ahead.

The WCTC Foundation is pleased to recognize our generous donors and achievements for Fiscal Years 2004 and 2005 in this Biennial Report. On behalf of the Foundation Board of Directors, I extend deep appreciation for the thoughtful giving demonstrated by the benefactors to the WCTC Foundation. 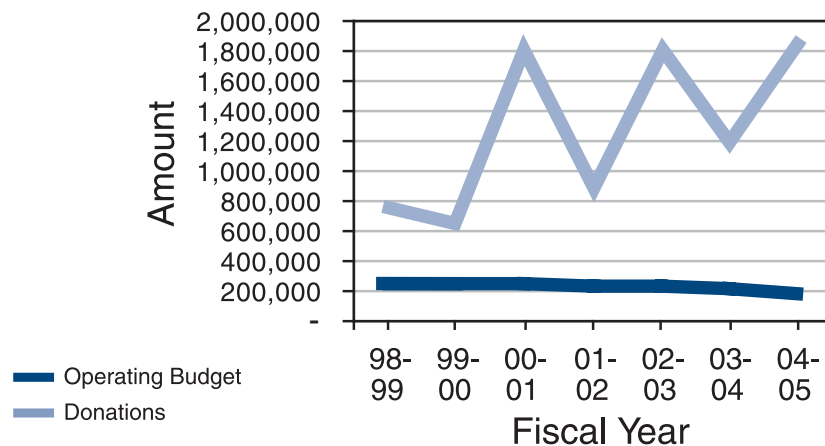

WCTC Foundation Financial/Operating Structure

The WCTC Foundation's operating expenses approximate \$225,000 per year. The Foundation does not receive administrative fees from donations. The Foundation's operating budget is funded through fee-for-services, property revenues and fund balance.



WCTC Foundation Events

Craft Fair

The Dickens Holiday Craft Fair is held each year. This event features exhibitors who have been selected for their creativity, product and presentation. Proceeds from this craft fair are used to fund student scholarships at Waukesha County Technical College. Each year, over \$14,500 is raised to benefit scholarships for students attending WCTC.

Legacy Scholarship Luncheon

The Legacy Scholarship Fund was established in 2003 to benefit WCTC students. The WCTC Foundation, Inc. is dedicated to seeking support for WCTC students through scholarships, assisting the needs related to the College's academic programs and advancing educational opportunities for the community through charitable support. The Foundation is governed by a voluntary and independent board of community leaders. In the past two years, this event has raised over \$15,000.

Wine Tasting

The annual Wine Tasting and Silent Auction event is sponsored by WCTC's Hospitality & Culinary Management Association and the WCTC Foundation. This special event is held to help raise money for scholarships and other educational opportunities for students in the Culinary Management Program and the Hotel and Restaurant Management Program at WCTC. Over \$40,000 has been raised in the past two fiscal years.

Jay Balchunas Memorial Scholarship Fund

Ashley Zielinski Dental Hygiene Memorial Scholarship Fund

Ashley Anne Zielinski was pursuing a career in Dental Hygiene at the time of her death. She believed in, respected and was very committed to the Dental Hygiene Program at WCTC. 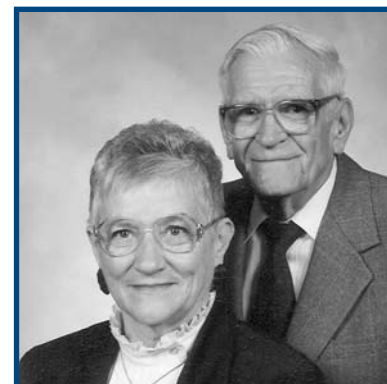
In Memory of James M. Barg and Lew Butler Scholarship Fund

Ways to Give

Gift support to the WCTC Foundation can greatly enhance student learning. There are several avenues in which you may support the Foundation. Providing direct gifts of cash, in-kind gifts, and planned gifts are just a few options.

Cash

For many of the supporters of the WCTC Foundation, cash donations are the most popular avenue in which to make monetary donations. Cash contributions are tax deductible and may provide federal and state tax savings.

Gifts of Stocks/Securities

These types of gifts provide the donor with the opportunity to avoid capital gains and at the same time, make a substantial gift to the WCTC Foundation.

Matching Gifts

Planned Giving

Planning a deferred gift to the WCTC Foundation, Inc. is a practical way for you to actualize your philanthropic goals and at the same time realize significant tax savings. There are a number of ways to establish a deferred gift to the WCTC Foundation, Inc.

Memorials and Honorary Gifts

Many donors wish to give a gift in memory of or in honor of a loved one, or a special friend. Endowments, Scholarships and Advised Funds are only a few of the many memorial and honorary gift opportunities available to donors.



Types of Funding

There are several funding options in which you may support the WCTC Foundation, Inc. These options have been developed to meet the needs of our many donors.

Endowments

An endowment with the WCTC Foundation is an excellent tool for making a perpetual scholarship gift. An investment of \$10,000 establishes a named endowment to benefit a specific category of students or a field of study that has been chosen by the donor. To accomplish this goal, gift commitments may be completed over a five-year period. Scholarships are awarded beginning the semester after the \$10,000 goal is reached.

Named Scholarships

Named Scholarships are established to recognize a particular individual or organization. The purpose of the scholarship may be designated specifically by the donor. Honorary and memorial scholarships usually define a field of interest specifically related to the donor’s motivation. All Named Scholarships are promoted to students with information about the source of funding and purpose of the scholarship.

Advised Funds

Another form of support is through an Advised Fund. An Advised Fund is used for the support of specific programs of a department or division and/or the support of students enrolled at WCTC. Donors designating their gifts to an Advised Fund may restrict their gift to student assistance, staff development, materials, equipment, supplies, etc.

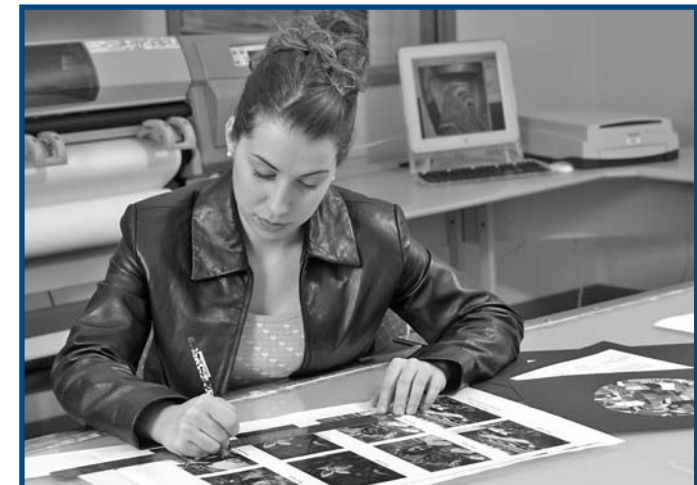
