# Advanced Standing CLEP & AP Policy

Students may be awarded credit for a course by achieving a satisfactory score on an exam with nationally recognized standards, including Advanced Placement (AP) exams with a score of 3 or higher or the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) exam with a score of 50 or above. Advanced standing for CLEP and AP credit will only be awarded if a student is admitted to a program at WCTC. Official CLEP or AP score reports must be submitted to the WCTC Admissions Office. An Advanced Standing form must be completed by the program counselor or Associate Dean and submitted to Registration and Records for approval.
