# Apply for admission

## into a WCTC associate degree or technical diploma program

### 1. Submit an application and pay the \$30 application fee.

### 2. Request transcripts

- Send official high school or GED/HSED transcripts. Transcripts must arrive at WCTC in their original sealed envelope or from a verified electronic transcript delivery service; opened transcripts will not be accepted.

### 3. Complete placement testing\*

- ACCUPLACER® is used to assist with appropriate placement in coursework. This test will assess your skills in Reading, Writing and Math.
- Official ACT, Compass, Asset, or TABE Advanced test results will exempt an applicant from the full or partial test. We accept scores that are no older than five years.
- Placement testing may not be required, in whole or in part, based on completed college coursework. Courses must be in the specific testing area(s) and you must have earned a grade of C or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) in the courses.
