About the Program

EMT Basic gives students the skills to assess and manage all types of medical illnesses and traumatic injuries. Airway management, bleeding and shock, emergency childbirth and automatic external defibrillation are just a few of topics covered.

Upon completion of the program, graduates are eligible to take the National Registry examination to become a licensed EMT in Wisconsin.

Admission Process

- Must be age 17 or older; must be 18 years old by the completion date of the course to be eligible to take the state licensure exam
- Candidates affiliated with a Waukesha District fire department or ambulance service are given priority for class enrollment
