

# Technical Studies - Journeyworker

60-credit Associate of Applied Science Degree

## About the Program

If a student possesses a Wisconsin Journey-level Certificate from an apprenticeship program that included at least 400 hours of related instruction, the student can design an associate degree around individual needs while receiving up to 32 advanced standing credits toward the occupational specific program requirements.

## Admission Process

- Fill out a WCTC application
- Send \$30 non-refundable application fee
- Send high school transcript or GED/HSED
- Send any previous college transcripts
- Complete Skills Assessment test (COMPASS)
- Begin pursuing Financial Aid options
- Select Wisconsin Journey-level apprenticeship courses may qualify the student for advance standing in this program

## Degree Completion Requirements

- Possess a Wisconsin Apprenticeship Completion Certificate issued by the Department of Workforce Development–Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards registered program which included a minimum of 400 hours of prescribed apprentice related instruction in the Wisconsin Technical College System. The certificate will meet the 36 credit minimum Technical Studies requirement for the associate of applied science degree.
- Additional Technical Studies advanced standing, calculated at one (1) credit per 36 hours of instruction, will be granted for prescribed apprentice related instruction beyond the 400 hour statutory minimum.
- Meet the Wisconsin Technical College System associate of applied science degree requirement for a minimum of 21 credits of General Education distributed across the following categories:

Communications	6 credits
Social Science	3 credits
Behavioral Science	3 credits
Math and/or Science	3 credits
Additional General Education	6 to 15 credits

- Complete at least 25% of the total program credits through coursework undertaken at WCTC and meet any institutional graduation requirements.
