

National Standards USPAP - 15 hours

Commencing January 1, 2003, real property appraisers seeking state licensure or certification credit for fulfilling USPAP course requirements must take the 15-hour National USPAP Course, or its equivalent, or the 7-hour National USPAP Update Course, or its equivalent. Only AQB Certified USPAP instructors can teach the National USPAP Courses.

This 15-hour course is designed to satisfy state appraisal licensing requirements and ethics established by The Appraisal Foundation and also covers appropriate Wisconsin State Statutes and rules for the real property appraiser/assessor seeking professional development and continuing education.
