Resolution outlining the

UW-Green Bay/Waukesha County Technical College Alliance

All graduates of Waukesha County Technical College earning an applied associate degree will transfer a minimum of 60 credits with Junior status to the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay through the Bachelor of Applied Studies Degree Program.

WHEREAS Waukesha County Technical College and UW-Green Bay are committed to keeping Wisconsin's economy strong; and

WHEREAS Waukesha County Technical College and UW-Green Bay are dedicated to providing new opportunities for professional advancement and human fulfillment through higher education; and

WHEREAS higher educational opportunities are necessary for vital growth and to assure a strong economy in Southeast Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS the citizens of Wisconsin and their elected officials have expressed the strong need for clear pathways leading to a University of Wisconsin bachelor's degree that recognizes the valuable education completed on campuses of the Wisconsin Technical College System; and

WHEREAS place-bound residents of the counties of Southeast Wisconsin have previous college experience and have expressed a collective need for additional University of Wisconsin degree options to be made available in the region; and

WHEREAS Waukesha County Technical College provides high-quality associate degrees to the people of Southeast Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS this partnership will include the transfer of Waukesha County Technical College applied associate degrees and college credits into UW-Green Bay's Adult Degree Program via the Bachelor of Applied Studies degree; and



WHEREAS UW-Green Bay will commit to providing an advisor/recruiter located at Waukesha County Technical College; and


WHEREAS Waukesha County Technical College will be responsible for meeting the space needs for the UW-Green Bay advisor/recruiter;
