Both institutions agree to maintain accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission and any other accreditation currently in existence pertaining to degree programs articulated via the transfer agreement.

### **Purpose of Articulation Agreement**

This program-to-program articulation agreement between UW-Whitewater and Wisconsin Technical College System allows students to be guaranteed admission to the fully online Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education degree and be awarded 43 credits toward the Bachelor of Science in Education and transferrable general education courses, if they meet the following criteria:

- 1. successfully complete the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.)-Early Childhood Education at any Wisconsin Technical College offering this degree.
- 2. earn a cumulative GPA of a 2.5 (less than 72 transferrable credits) or 2.75 (72+ transferrable credits) (on a 4.0 scale), including coursework from other institutions (if appropriate), and according to UW-W repeat policy: <a href="https://www.uww.edu/registrar/policies#repeats">https://www.uww.edu/registrar/policies#repeats</a>
- 3. have applied to and are successfully admitted into UW-Whitewater (all UW-Whitewater application deadlines apply) beginning fall 2025 and any subsequent terms: <a href="https://www.uww.edu/admissions/transfer">https://www.uww.edu/admissions/transfer</a>
- 4. declare the Bachelor Science in Education Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education major at time of admission/upon transfer to UW-Whitewater.

This articulation does not guarantee admission to the Early Childhood/Early Childhood Special Education degree delivered in person at UW-Whitewater campus.

#### Admission to Professional Education

Admission to UWW does NOT guarantee admission to the professional program in the UWW College of Education and Professional Studies. Admission into the UWW College of Education Professional Education Program is based upon the student's successful completion of academic and non- academic criteria determined by the College of Education and Professional Studies. These criteria are as follows (also available on the Admission to Professional Education website):

- Completion of 30 degree credits (transferable credits and UWW credits).
- 2.75 combined cumulative grade point average on transferable credits, or Completion of an approved AAS or AA degree in Early Childhood Education, or Qualifying test scores.
- Completed applications and test scores (if applicable) must be submitted by the posted deadlines on the COEPS Admission webpage.

#### **Additional Conditions**

- Program to Program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the degree specified in this agreement.
   A change of major invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other Program to Program Articulation Agreement for a different major at UWW.
- UW-Whitewater College of Education and Professional Studies will accept Credit for Prior Learning (CPL)/Work Experience credits from the WTCS for students transferring to UWW with an A.A.S. Early Childhood degree. The grade for the course will be accepted as assigned by the technical college administering the degree. When transferring to UWW up to 9 credits of CPL/Work Experience can be accepted towards the Program to Program Articulation Agreement in Early Childhood Education.
- Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the curriculum of the WTCS or UWW undergoes revision.
- The A.A.S. degree in Early Childhood Education must be posted on official transcripts to receive credits from the agreement.

#### **Courses and Requirements Remaining to Degree**

Once students are admitted they will be required to meet the following criteria for graduation and recommendation for licensure.

- Students must meet UWW's general education requirements.
- Students must meet the B.S.E. requirements of the College of Education and Professional Studies.
- Other Requirements:
  - Students must earn a 2.75 Combined Cumulative GPA and Major GPA before student teaching and before graduation.
  - o Students must take at least 30 credits at UWW to satisfy the residency requirement.
  - Students must earn a 3.0 in their Content Courses or pass the Praxis II with qualifying scores

#### **Additional Conditions**

- 1. Program-to-program transfer courses/credits are accepted only for the major/emphasis combination specified in this agreement. A change of major and/or emphasis invalidates these courses/credits for transfer unless they are approved within some other program-to-program articulation agreement for a different major at UW-Whitewater.
- 2. Course equivalencies specified in this articulation agreement are subject to change in the event that the course curricula of relevant programs at Wisconsin Technical Colleges or at UW-Whitewater undergo revision.
- **3.** For students admitted from Wisconsin Technical Colleges with a completed Early Childhood Education Associate degree, the degree must be posted on an official transcript to receive credits from the agreement.
- **4.** This Articulation Agreement is effective fall 2025 and shall remain in effect for five years, unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- **5.** UW-Whitewater and Wisconsin Technical Colleges agree to assist each other in appropriately promoting this agreement in their respective marketing materials, events, websites, and reports.
