
Ihree years, two careers!

The dual degree option maximizes synergies between the Business Management and Supply Chain Management Programs through the sharing of resources, such as faculty expertise, facilities and community programs. Students taking Business Management and Supply Chain Management will graduate with additional skills making them more marketable to both industries.

The dual option features an abbreviated schedule, a diverse environment, and enhanced opportunities for collaboration and networking.

The Business Management and Supply Chain Management option totals 88 credits, and it is structured to be completed over three years.




- Business Management: assistant manager, production specialist, account coordinator, business development specialist, branch manager.
