☐ Submit an application and pay the \$30 application fee

☐ Request transcripts

- Send official high school or GED/HSED transcripts. Transcripts must arrive at WCTC in their original sealed envelope or from a verified electronic transcript delivery service.
- Send official college and/or military transcripts. For more information on transfer of credit procedures go to www.wctc.edu/prior-learning.

☐ Complete a placement assessment, if required for your program

You can demonstrate your reading, writing, and/or math skills in one or more of the following ways:

- High school GPA of 2.60 or above within the last fifteen years.
- Official ACT, ACCUPLACER®, Compass, Asset, GED Reasoning Through Language Arts-2014 Series (165 or higher), or TABE Advanced test results. Scores no older than five years are accepted.
- Completed college coursework may meet this requirement in whole or in part. Courses must be in the specific area(s), and you must have earned a grade of C or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) in the courses.
- If none of the above apply, sign up for the ACCUPLACER® placement test at www.wctc.edu/testing.
