

Traffic Safety/Point Reduction course

This course is designed to correct improper, undesirable and illegal driving habits and behaviors.

This Traffic Safety/Point Reduction course is designed to reduce the number of violations and crashes in Wisconsin.

Registration

Course tuition payment and driver's license number are required at the time of registration.

- » If paying with check or cash, registration must be made in-person.
- » If paying with a credit or debit card, registration can be either in-person or over the phone.

Course

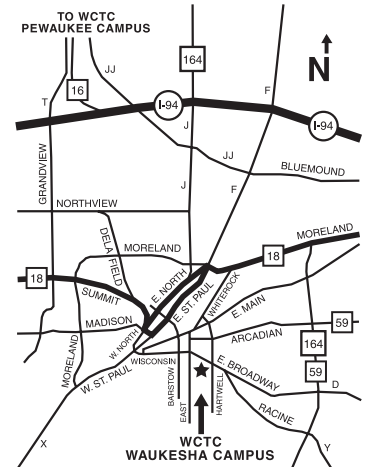
Length – 15 hours

- With six or more demerit points on your record, enrollment may be voluntary or mandatory. Upon completion on the course, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation/Division of Motor Vehicles will allow a reduction of three (3) demerit points from your driving record.
- Studies of the driving records of individuals referred to this Traffic Safety course by the court indicate a substantial reduction in the number of violations and accidents.
